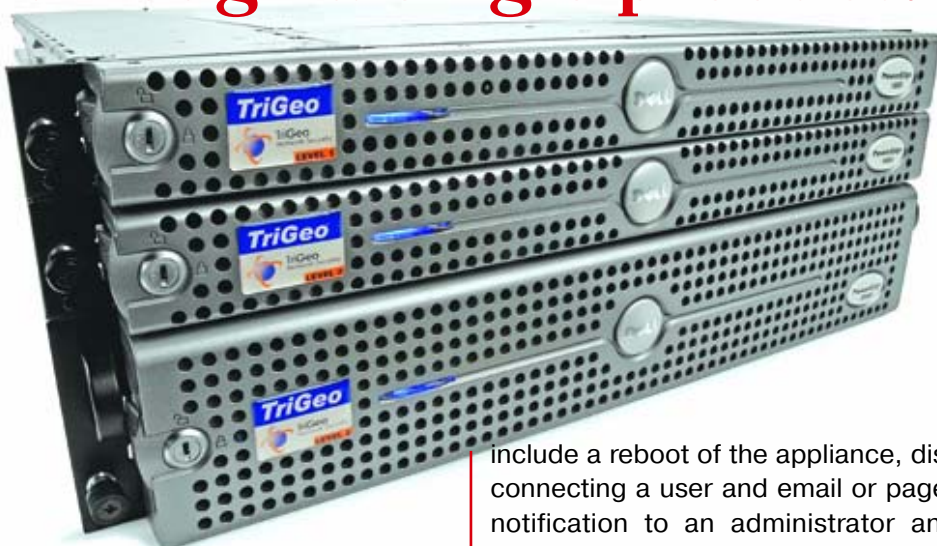


Monitor activities of network appliances through a single product.



System administrators and their IT assistants have enough work to do with the day-to-day chores of such positions that they hardly have any time to scour through the logs of multiple network appliances. While some of them have the capacity to alert key personnel in case of failure or network threat, we are impressed with the fact that the TriGeo Security Information Management Appliance can provide a single interface to monitor the activity of a multitude of appliances used in the network and this product wins our Editor's Choice Award for value and performance.

We would be negligent if we didn't mention that it will take time to configure each of the appliances with the TriGeo Security Information Management appliance. The product uses agents or the log files of the various appliances to determine the activities of users or in the case of an IDS device whether there is a threat to the network. Based on these user rules there are several different types of actions that can occur using the TriGeo Automated Remediation through Intelligent Correlation feature which

include a reboot of the appliance, disconnecting a user and email or pager notification to an administrator and their staff. To make the job somewhat easier, the unit ships with around 500 rules already predefined.

There are more than 100 network products that already work with the TriGeo Security Information Management appliance that include Linux and Windows workstations, firewalls, IDS products, routers, switches and even some anti-virus software products. Products known to work with this appliance includes those from Juniper, Cisco, TopLayer Networks, WatchGuard Technologies, Fortinet, SonicWALL, Snort, Norton, Check Point Software and Microsoft. We understand that others are currently in the works as well.

Although it the targeted market is aimed at small to medium-sized businesses, the TriGeo Security Information Management appliance has the capacity to monitor the activities of up to 50,000 devices at any given time. More than 220 reports are available from this appliance that can inform administrators of the activities of all of the attached devices. Using the Business Objects' Crystal Reports
